The only clinic specifically for Baltimore's uninsured opens at 1927 St. Paul Street owned by Seventh Baptist Church. University Baptist Church provides much of the working capital. Richard Pelham donates his medical and office equipment & supplies. Pt. visits = 1 hr. of wage. Value of services \$30,600.

A Unique Partnership is Born: Union Memorial Hospital & Shepherd's Clinic. Hospital's physicians provide volunteer specialty consultations and serve patients upon referral. The hospital also provides diagnostic procedures and surgery.

Union Memorial Residents begin working in the clinic as part of their training.

The clinic is moved into 1901 St. Paul Street also owned by the Seventh Baptist Church.

The William H.M. Finney Foundation is created. Gastroenterology, dermatology, cardiology, & psychiatry services added. Monthly patient education classes on diabetes & hypertension start.

Gynecology, physical therapy, and dental services are offered.

Weight-loss classes added. Union Memorial limits referrals to zip code areas closest to the hospital.

Services expanded to include endocrine clinic. Dr. William Finney, the clinic's first medical director, dies.

Study reveals 61% of female patients have experienced partner violence, and over half have symptoms consistent with major depression.

Having outgrown its location, 2800 Kirk Ave is purchased by William H.M. Finney Foundation. The Foundation embarks on first capital campaign.

Shepherd's Clinic celebrates 15th Anniversary in its new home at 2800 Kirk Avenue. Podiatry clinic is added. Value of services > \$1M

Two volunteer MDs dream of a kitchen to teach patients healthy cooking. Volunteers and staff mobilize and Joy Wellness Center is born. Mental health program expanded.

New patients almost double & volunteer hours increase 35%. Joy Wellness Center and Behavioral Health offer full programming. Building & grounds greatly enhanced.

Patient visits expand to over 5,000 and volunteers increase to more than 300. Difficult economy drives many newly uninsured patients to our door.

A record 511 new patients, with an influx of men. 357 volunteers make it happen. Economy still struggles. Shepherd's Clinic celebrates 20 wonderful years.

Shepherd's Clinic

It's remarkable that the clinic has thrived for 20 years. In some ways, this is an incredible success story. Twenty years ago, a group of volunteers that included Jack VandenHengel and my grandfather, Dr. Bill Finney, recognized that there were thousands of people in this city who earned enough that they didn't qualify for government assistance, but for whom private insurance was still out of reach. This group of volunteers had an idea. They would open a primary care clinic for the uninsured. Patients would be asked to pay an hour's wage, if they could afford it. The doctors and nurses would volunteer their time, keeping costs low.

In return for keeping these patients out of their emergency room, Union Memorial would provide follow-up and specialty care—a deal that came with a promise from the clinic to use the hospital's resources carefully. This model has worked well, and it has stood the test of time.

At the same time, a generation of residents, medical students, nursing students, college students—and now social workers, pharmacists, and wellness practitioners—have learned the meaning of compassionate care from Shepherd's Clinic. They've taken the spirit of this place out into the larger healthcare world.

We've done all of this for 20 years without a dollar of private or public sector reimbursement. In the last fiscal year, all told, we had almost 6,500 patient visits. A record. During that same time, more than 500 new patients walked through the door. Another record. And the numbers are still growing.

Many people are telling us that this is the first time in their lives they've been without health insurance. In these tough times, I think we all know someone like this. They never expected to find themselves in such a tough situation, but they also never expected to find a place like the clinic.

This is a testament to the care and support that so many people provide. Each volunteer and every donor is essential, and we need more. Especially now. The word is out. Shepherd's Clinic is open for

business, and people are coming. We are in the process of expanding our capacity so that new patients can be seen without undue delay. We can't do it without every one of you.

And so the work goes on. And it will for another 20 years, as long as there are people in the city who can't afford healthcare anywhere else. As long as Union Memorial continues to be our invaluable partner. And as long as members of Baltimore's medical community, and the community at large, continue to volunteer here and to support us financially. On behalf of the entire board, I would like to thank each of you.
