Primary & Specialty Care

Whom do we serve?

Shepherd's Clinic is proud to provide comprehensive free primary and specialty medical and behavioral health care to Baltimore residents **18 years of age and older who are uninsured and cannot afford health insurance.** To qualify for medical services, you must live in one of the following zip codes:

21206, 21211, 21212, 21213, 21214, 21215, 21217, 21218, 21234, and 21239.

Shepherd's Clinic is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization. We do not charge fees or bill our patients for care. But if you are working, we suggest that you donate an hour's wage, or if you are unemployed, we ask that you contribute \$9 per office visit.

Services we are unable to provide include: obstetrical care, emergency services, health care for homeless individuals, or those who are in the U.S. on a visitor's visa. We cannot complete disability claim forms for those who are not already our patients.

If you think you qualify

Please give us a call during clinic hours at **410-467-7140**. You will be screened over the phone, and if you qualify, we can make an appointment for you to be seen by a provider. If you are eligible for medical assistance, we will help you get enrolled.

Clinical Services

At Shepherd's Clinic, our primary care program offers our uninsured patients much needed health care. Our physicians and nurse practitioners conduct comprehensive medical evaluations.

Free services currently available include:

- Basic primary care
- Disease prevention and screening
- Physical exams
- Vaccinations
- Women's health including gynecological care (exception: we do not see pregnant women)
- Men's health
- Hospital and diagnostic services (partnership with MedStar Union Memorial and Good Samaritan Hospitals)
- Referrals to medical specialists in the community
- Prescription assistance

Behavioral Health Care

Our Behavioral Health Program provides:

- Behavioral health assessments
- Counseling and therapy
- Psychiatric services
- Case management and connection to resources
- Education

Getting to Shepherd's Clinic and the Joy Wellness Center is easy. We are in central Baltimore behind City College on the #36 MTA bus route. Parking is free.
